

2022: Train Gamers Association Major Tournament Structure

The TGA is an all-volunteer, non-profit organization overseen by a Board of Directors. The Board has established an independent Tournament Management Committee, consisting of two Senior Directors and a Regional Director, which has full authority and responsibility for all aspects of TGA tournaments.

MAJOR TOURNAMENT SENIOR LEADERSHIP (Senior Directors): These Senior Directors work closely together to manage convention and sponsor relations, convention volunteer activities, and all aspects of the TGA's major tournament preparation and on-site operations.

Trella Bromley is the Senior Director of Tournament Operations. This position has primary responsibility for the operational side of working with Origins and Gen Con, creating playing schedules, and coordinating on-site operations.

Jeff Jackson is the Senior Director of Tournament Systems. This position has primary responsibility for the rules and systems by which tournaments and games are organized and played, and for developing and implementing the structures and processes under which TGA convention volunteers operate.

CONVENTION ON-SITE LEADERSHIP: Each major tournament has a Head Conductor (HC) and a Convention Headquarters Conductor (HQC), appointed and overseen by the Senior Directors. Head Conductors have autonomy as to logistics and management of their conventions, within established guidelines. The Headquarters Conductor manages the HQ area, coordinates data entry and convention admin, and works with the Head Conductor to ensure everything runs smoothly. The team for 2022:

CONDUCTORS AND VOLUNTEERS AT ORIGINS AND GEN CON

At any point in time there will be a designated Conductor on Duty, plus other Volunteers helping to run things. **David Belew** assists the Senior Directors by coordinating volunteers for Origins and Gen Con in advance of the tournaments. All volunteers work under the direction of the convention Head Conductor, coordinating with the Headquarters Conductor, and supported by the Senior Directors.

QUESTIONS, COMMENTS, SUGGESTIONS, CONCERNS ?

For any issue regarding a game in progress, you can speak to the Conductor on Duty. If you do not know who that is, ask any Volunteer to help you find out. If the issue cannot be resolved by the Conductor on Duty, it can be escalated to the Head Conductor or to a Senior Director.

For issues regarding the convention rules or organization, please talk to Trella or Jeff. For general concerns or Code of Conduct issues, please talk to Amy or Jeff. If you wish to volunteer to help (thanks!), please talk to David or a Senior Director.

2022: What Else Does the TGA Do ?

REGIONAL TOURNAMENTS (all other conventions beyond Origins, Gen Con, and Railcon):

Phil Cottrell, our Regional Tournament Director, is in charge of sanctioning conventions that wish to run an official Puffing Billy Tournament or other TGA-affiliated events. He has information about becoming a conductor, getting started, and sanctioning a PBT, modified PBT, or other TGA affiliated train game tournament. If you represent a local convention that might be interested in running a TGA-sanctioned event, please talk to Phil, or ask one of our Volunteers how to get in touch with him.

TOURNAMENT RESULTS TRACKING:

Phil Cottrell is also our TGA Results Coordinator. Phil has compiled our major tournament results over the past 10 years, and is developing a new approach for tracking results and PB points over the years. Check out the initial report that is posted on the wall. Ideas welcome!
