

# EXPRESS TOURNAMENT RULES

The TGA has adopted the following rules change for Puffing Billy® tournament play of Express:

**A player may not go out on the same turn he or she plays a Wild Car as a transition card.**

Relevant Clarifications:

If the Wild car is played as any freight or passenger car, the player may go out on that turn.

A Wild may be played as the last car of a train and not covered, and the player is not required to declare whether it is a transition or a matching car. On the following turn that player may use the Wild either way, and may go out on that turn. If another player goes out, a Wild on the end is scored as a matching car.

Playing a Turntable gives the player an additional turn.

Tournament Express is played to 120 points, scheduled for a two hour time slot. Three hours will be allotted for the final.
