

Trans America/Europa TGA Game Play Rev 2017

GAME LENGTH

- With three players, play two rounds to completion. A round is defined as each player having acted as Lead Player once.
- With four or more players, play one round to completion.

SCORING

- Keep a running tally of each player's score through all rounds.
- The player with the lowest tallied score will be the winner, but that form of scoring will not calculate correctly for tournament play.
- Therefore each player's score to be reported on the score sheet must be calculated by subtracting the final tallied score from 100.
- If a calculated score would be negative, record it as 0.

Metro Rules Clarifications clarified 2016

Several Metro rules have been widely misunderstood or poorly translated.

These are the definitive TGA rules:

- Multiple players may be on the same point on the scoring track at the same time.
- Any play that would result in a route scoring 1 point is illegal
- A tile may NOT be placed so the tracks ON THAT TILE ONLY exit the board from the same square where the route began (without leaving the square)
- A tile MAY BE PLAYED such that the route scored exits from the same square where it began, as long as the route first leaves the square (thus scoring at least 2)
- If no legal tile play exists (usually near the end of the game), a player may be forced to make an illegal play with a score of 1 point
